The government maintains an Orange Alert in the departments of La Paz, Cuscatlan, San Vicente, San Salvador and La Libertad

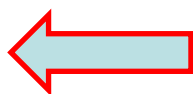

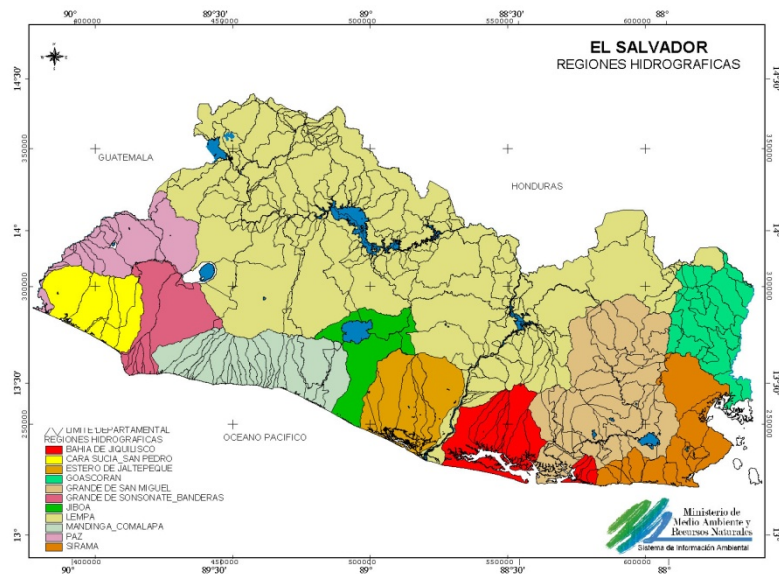
