### **ANNUAL REPORT OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE PAN AMERICAN SANITARY BUREAU**

#### **CLOSING THE GAPS IN HEALTH IN THE LEAST PROTECTED POPULATIONS**

1. The fourth line in paragraph 70 should read:

...slogans “Take the Test” in **Suriname** and “**Know Your Status**” in the **Bahamas**...

2. Paragraph 145 should read:

145. The Country Cooperation Strategy (CCS) constitutes a key element of technical cooperation from which transformations in countries are implemented. In the last four years, CCS has been established in Bolivia, Costa Rica, Guyana, Honduras, Mexico, Nicaragua, and Venezuela. It is in the final approval phase in Colombia, El Salvador, Guatemala, Jamaica, Suriname, and Trinidad and Tobago. It is currently under way in Cuba, Panama, Peru, the Dominican Republic, and Uruguay; and it is slated to begin in October 2006 in the Bahamas. Argentina, Belize, Brazil, Chile, Ecuador, and Haiti have decided to initiate CCS in 2007.
