





MANAGING CONFLICT OF INTEREST IN PAF





- Shared values and commitment (invite you sign)
- Application and due diligence process
- Rights and responsibilities/rules of participation
- Differentiate policy ("WHAT" is to be done) decided by public health authorities from action ("HOW" we achieve these goals) where members work together
- Engage diverse range of government, civil society, academic and business entities to ensure no one has undue influence and hold each other accountable
- Tobacco, Alcohol, Firearms not allowed; fundamentally opposed to public health
