 - International Response Teams deployed (GOARN, other mechanisms).



Outbreak Response with Deployment of International Teams



International Health Regulations, Epidemic Alert and Response, and Water Borne Diseases

Information

- Dissemination of information:
 - Importance of disseminating clinical information, epidemiological updates, new / updated guidelines and recommendations on Surveillance, Laboratory, Case Management, Infection Control, Bio-Risk management (English, Spanish);
 - Awareness and Response of HCW regarding detection of unusual / unexpected SARI events at all levels of care.
- Exchange of information through IHR channel:
 - Dialogue between WHO regional IHR Contact Point and IHR National Focal Points for joint risk assessment.





PAHO/WHO Response

- Regional on going / performed activities include:
 - Articulation of Laboratory network around WHO CCs (Influenza, Coronavirus) and National Influenza Centers;
 - Training on Bio Risk Management for shipment of samples;
 - Integration in global surveillance networks;








PAHO/WHO Response
